


HOST: I am very pleased to welcome the architect Álvaro Álvarez and, well, we are going to talk about an exhibition that has to do with a very very large project that is being carried out in all the coastal cities of the North of Baja California, and how it was stopped, and how it begins to start. Álvaro, how nice to have you here. Good morning, thank you for being with us and, let's see, tell me a little about what the project was in the beginning, which is now being resumed, and why did it stop?

ALVARO: Sure. Thank you very much for allowing me to tell this story. This project is called "46 Revivals" and tells the story of the COCOTREN, also known as the Tijuana Rosarito and Ensenada Coastal Corridor. It is a stretch of highway.

HOST: It's the highway we know, right? That goes from Tijuana to Ensenada. Beautiful. Tell me a little about the project and then we'll cover how it becomes art; Where did this project come from and what was it for?

ALVARO: This project was born 10 years ago, when my grandfather and I began studying it. My grandfather Luis Bustamante, whom I love and admire very much, began to revive these projects little by little, metaphorically applying (I believe) chest compressions, and today, thank God, they are being reborn. And I say "Reborn" because at the beginning of 2008, all of these were going to be built; it was going to be the largest development in the history of Baja California: multiple residential buildings and then it stopped in 2008. The art here is linking architecture and real estate development to celebrate this renaissance, and I as an artist am creating these sculptural works to mark this revival that we are going to experience.

HOST: Tell me, does it [the project] stop, and how does it get going again? I say it "stops" due to the economic recession, which you were talking about just now, but how are all the projects connected? What connects them is the corridor?


ALVARO: Exactly. That artery is what unites them all; it transcends municipalities from Tijuana, Rosarito, and Ensenada, and is also connecting them metaphorically because all of these were originally going to be purchased by North American investors. What we are going to see now, thanks to many investments from Mexican developers, is that many Baja Californians will also be able to invest.

HOST: We've seen a lot of them right? We have seen along the coast how it is growing. Now, in what way does it draw your attention to create a work of art, talking about these constructions and all this investment? On a truly beautiful highway, which those of us who live here have the opportunity to explore continuously. The sunsets, the entire corridor is a beautiful place, but how do you reconcile all this?

ALVARO: I have been personally obsessed with this project for ten years. It started with a research piece I did while at Cornell University and has eventually continued to grow as we get more information. And the reason why it is so important for me to tell this story through art is because we are experiencing this positive transformation in our state, and I think that every time a society like ours experiences these transformations, it is very important to record it, and that it be documented, so as not to let it just pass by, but rather to be able to celebrate it as a project that belongs to all of us here in Baja California.

HOST: And it will benefit us; economically and in a thousand ways. We have a lot of tourism and this will increase it even more.

ALVARO: Exactly. Additionally we are taking control of our own narrative. No one else can tell our story anymore; instead it is us talking about the coast's uprising. It's a beautiful road, but when you drive, you're seeing concrete skeletons, which we normalized it for many years. We don't even pay attention to them anymore.

HOST: You know to expect them already, the steel beams left behind. And you, as an architect, tell me a little about these constructions that you have seen? Architecturally, is there any shape or something that distinguishes the architecture of this corridor?


ALVARO: Each one is special. Each of these forty-six constructions has its own personality. They are all large scale, but architecturally, some are more symmetrical, some are more densely packed, and others are more distributed. What these works of art are doing is representing the architectural essence of each one of them, and this is a good example of a project called Vita e Mare, located at Kilometer 17/18, which was going to be a tower – more of 300 housing units, and had this linear design that brought it closer to the coast. So now this sculptural manifestation represents that same typology, so to speak. It becomes in a sense an altar to the soul of the project.

HOST: Tell me something: the technique of the works that are going to be presented: what is it and why did you choose this technique?

ALVARO: The way I'm building them is I take a wooden panel, then I create a type of shell with metal and plastic underneath, and on top I come with a layer of paper that creates this texture and directionality. And the reason why I chose these materials, and obviously in the end painted with layers of ink and black plaster, but all these materials used in these works were also abandoned in a warehouse, so I am creating a connection where we take the abandonment and it is rebuilt, it is reborn – which is what is happening right now on the coast as we speak.

HOST: Tell me about the exhibition, when, how, and where will it be?

ALVARO: The exhibition will be for one day. On Thursday, November 2nd, 11am in Plaza del Mar, in Rosarito. Kilometer 57, in the Pyramid section. Everyone is welcome, and we are going to witness 46 works like these.

HOST: Did you do all of them yourself?

ALVARO: Yes.

HOST: Are the forty-six works yours?

ALVARO: Yes.

HOST: Generally, we relate an architect with construction and the art in construction. In this case, you apply the art to the pieces - I don't know if the name is correct – in a decorative manner, but in the end pieces that can be mounted in an exhibition. How is architecture connected to art that can be exhibited in a museum or gallery?

ALVARO: I think the connection is very strong. Personally, I have always liked art, although I studied architecture and practiced architecture for five years. Since I was a child, I came to architecture by drawing. So when I was presented with the opportunity to express this project, now that I can speak this other language that is visual art, it became very easy for me to be able to represent it in this way. And even more so as it is linked to Mexican spirituality on Day of the Dead, which is when we are going to have this event.


HOST: It's great. So, repeat dates to me. It's November 2nd; what time do you open?




TITLE: "46 REVIVALS: THE EMOTIONAL RESURRECTION OF THE BAJA CALIFORNIA

COAST THROUGH THE ART OF ALVARO ALVAREZ."

CONTENT: "46 Revivals" is an artistic project that represents the 46 architectural developments located in the 145 kilometers of the Tijuana-Rosarito-Ensenada Coastal Corridor, also known as COCOTREN, which were interrupted in 2008 due to the financial recession at that time. Over the years, they remained in a limbo of suspended construction, with their beams and concrete exposed to the sea, awaiting a resolution from their investors or response from the local community. This 2023 we celebrate that the Bustamante Business Center team has managed to revive all of these projects, giving them a second chance to be re-developed through significant sales and negotiations.

> The 46 Renaissances artistic project began 10 years ago when architect and artist Alvaro Andres Alvarez Bustamante investigated and cataloged these 46 stopped real estate developments, consolidating all the information in a report that was published by Cornell University in New York. Now that a decade has passed, Álvaro has created forty-six pictorial sculptures in paper, gesso, and ink that interpret the architectural spirit of each of these developments.

> All the materials used in the works were also abandoned in a warehouse and were similarly rescued by the artist for a new use. This artistic intervention occurs exactly 15 years after the bankruptcy declaration of Lehman Brothers on September 15, 2008, which was the great trigger of the global real estate crisis and contributed mainly to the interruption of the 46 developments in Tijuana, Rosarito, and Ensenada.


Ceremony

Preparing for this inaugural Day of the Dead ceremony is similar to organizing a ritual: guests must be summoned, the place must be cleaned, and the protocol must be organized similarly to orchestrating a ritualistic procession. "46 Revivals" provokes an emotional reaction by covering stigmatized topics such as community abandonment; This offers us an opportunity to reconfigure the dialogue previously structured around the topic of abandoned architecture, and to be the ones who tell the story of Baja California. The desired goal of "46 Revivals" is to invoke a sense of collective respect for the dignity of the forty-six projects, as well as to share the excitement of a second chance at life.

The artistic project will be publicly exhibited in a ceremony on the Day of the Dead, on November 2, 2023 in Plaza del Mar (Rosarito), in an event held inside one of the developments that has been successfully reborn, creating a strong bond between works of art and architectural works. Through this ceremony and exhibition, we will be able to share the story of what we experienced in Baja California in recent years, and how the architectural souls suspended from these buildings finally manage to rest, opening the door to a new future in our beautiful coast.
